Come join the summer fun at Girls Inc. We have a full summer of activities planned and we think that the girls will love them.

We will also be offering trips out of the center throughout the summer. The best way to be notified of these events is to sign-up for our weekly email newsletter and it gives you and your daughter the opportunity to plan what events she might want to participate in that are in addition to all of the fun activities planned.

This summer all weeks will have a specific theme. This is an effort to provide 9 different experiences for the girls that attend and keep things fresh and fun while still providing an educational opportunity during this time.

June 1st - June 4th - "I am STRONG, SMART, and BOLD"

This week will focus mainly on teamwork and getting to know each other. We really want the girls to mix and mingle with girls their own age to form friendships that will last this summer and beyond. We will also work on self-esteem, self worth, and self image.

June 7th - June 11th - "What on Earth"

This week will focus on Operation SMART. We will be teaching the girls about science, math, and relevant technology. It will be important for the girls to see what jobs are available in these areas as well as make them comfortable with the subjects. Girls tend to have low self-esteem when it comes to succeeding in math and science. We want to show them that we are confident in these areas and they should be too.



June 14th - June 18th - "Lights, Camera, Action"

This week will focus on drama and Media Literacy. We will be helping the girls to learn a play to perform at the end of the week. We will have set design, production team, and the actress team. During this week as well, we will provide them information about the media around them. We will learn what good media is and what the media does to influence the decisions we make. We want them to see that what the media shows you is not always the truth.

June 21st - June 25th - Survivor

This week will focus on learning survivor skills, first aide, and other things about nature. Possible trip to Devil's Den to explore nature as there may be a reward for attending classes and participating. We will incorporate Survivor game at the end of the week and make it a week long challenge. Girls EnCourage will be the main focus for some of the activities.

June 28th - July 2nd - Girls Inc. Idol

This week will focus on helping the girls see that everyone's talent is different and it's okay to be different from your friends and peers. We will have a talent show at the end of the week to showcase what the girls have learned and discovered about themselves.

July 6th - July 9th - "Cents and Sensibility"

This week will focus on teaching the girls about Economic Literacy and what it means as a woman. We will want to teach them how to work with a budget, learn to fill out job applications, go grocery shopping, and we will visit a bank and see how it all works. The girls will learn about money and how to spend and save wisely.

July 12th - July 16th - Project Runway

This week will introduce the girls to a new area they may know nothing about. We will teach the girls about the fashion industry reminding them of the lessons they learned from Media Literacy. They will also be designing their own outfit that will go down the runway at the end of the week. It will be a great opportunity for the girls to see different areas of work that are available to them.

July 19th - July 23rd - "Girls Go Green"

This week will be all about recycling and what we can do to help the environment. We will teach them about the process of recycling, what they can do to help, and what jobs are available for them. We want the girls to learn about what it means to be eco-friendly.

July 26th - July 30th - Girls Inc. Iron Chef

This is the final week of summer. We want to show the girls yet again another avenue that they can travel down for a career. We will work on cooking skills. We will have various "cook-offs". We also want to show the girls various meals that they can make for themselves and family members. We want to take the opportunity for the girls to learn something about the culinary arts.

What goes on the rest of the year at Girls Inc.

During the school year we provide recreational and educational activities after school from 3:00 - 6:00 daily and we are open on the days that Fort Smith Public Schools are dismissed (check calendar for specific days). We also offer a fall and spring volleyball league and a basketball league that is held from December thru February.
